REGULATIONS FOR VISITING THE PREMATURE BABY WARD

Please turn off your mobile phone before entering the premature baby ward

HYGIENE AND PRIVACY

- Please remove all jewelry (watches, rings and bracelets) before entering the premature baby ward.
- Wash and dry hands well when entering and leaving the premature baby ward.
- Do not go in if you are ill (if you have a cold, diarrhea or a fever).
- Brothers and sisters younger than 12 years old may only enter if they have not been in contact with children with childhood diseases.
- Other children under 12 years old are not allowed to enter.
- Babies also have a right to privacy. We therefore request that you only visit your 'own' baby.

DURING CARE AND FEEDING TIMES

- Parents are always welcome during care and feeding times.
- If only 1 parent is present, 1 visitor may also come in.
- In order to ensure a restful atmosphere, visitors may not alternate with each other.

VISITING HOURS

- Daily from 4 pm to 5 pm and from 6.30 to 7.30 pm.
- Week-ends and holidays from 10 am to 11 am, 4 to 5 pm and 6.30 to 7.30 pm.
- Visitors may only go in if there is at least 1 parent present.
- Along with the parents, no more than 2 people may go in at the same time.
- Because the babies need their rest, we request that you do not wake them or take them out of their beds.

It is possible that, during emergency situations, there will be no visiting allowed on the premature baby ward.
